### Course Description

Developed in 2001, the Train the Trainers (TTT) program concentrates on expanding the educational skills of educators in the fields of gastroenterology, hepatology, endoscopy, and GI surgery, who are responsible for teaching, through the use of current educational techniques and philosophies. It brings together faculty and participants from across the globe in an intensive and interactive workshop, characterized by numerous hands-on sessions with ample opportunity for discussion. This two-day advanced workshop will feature lectures from an array of industries with experience in various leadership areas.

Participants are required to engage actively in all sessions and social functions; hence they are required to attend all workshop days. In addition to fully participating in the program, we require that participants commit to the completion of the pre-workshop questionnaire, on-site evaluation, and post-workshop evaluation. Their responses assist WGO in best meeting their expectations prior to the workshop commencement and also serve as data that WGO compiles to measure the impact of the TTTs overall contribution to continuing education.

Participants must be **both** fluent in French and have at least a proficient level in English. With the exception of a few presentations and slides, presentations will be in French, along with the breakout sessions which will require active participation and/or discussion from all members of the group. Correspondence and course materials provided by the WGO Secretariat will be in English.

Some topics presented at this TTT Workshop will include: The Difficult Trainee, Skill Teaching, Meta-Analysis, Feedback and Trial Design.

### Learning Objectives

- Identify the major specificities of adult education
- Optimize the management of difficult team members
- Understand how to improve technical teaching skills
- Utilize the steps to improve feedback in a team
- Identify the main steps of a trial and publication to appraise its quality
- Evaluate basic statistics in a trial/paper
- Understand advanced statistics and meta-analysis

### Recommended Audience

This TTT is open to both WGO TTT Alumni and those who have never attended at standard, four-day TTT. TTT Alumni are only able to nominate themselves; WGO Member Society and WGO Training Center Directors may nominate up to two trainees who meet the qualifications below:

- Participants must be **both** fluent in French and have at least a proficient level in English.
- Is a Gastroenterologists, hepatologists, endoscopists, or GI surgeon
- Is currently responsible or is looking to train other health care professionals and would like the opportunity to enhance their leadership and training knowledge and skills
- **Participants are required to attend the entire workshop and should plan to arrive on the specified arrival and departure dates listed above.**
- Participant will commit to putting the TTT workshop lessons into place upon return to their own teaching environment.

### **Application Review**

Applications will be reviewed by for adherence to the above criteria and for equal geographical, gender and expertise distribution. Priority will be given to WGO member societies that have paid their dues through 2019 and WGO Training Center Directors that have completed their 2018 WGO Annual Report.

Applications will be reviewed in early February 2020 with notifications going out in late February 2020 to both the nominator and nominee via email.
